2024 - 2025 Go to High School, Go to College Scholarship Application Requirements

Eligibility Criteria

Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. Theta Theta Lambda Chapter will select high school seniors who demonstrate success in the following categories:

- Excellence Scholarship (\$2000)
- Leadership Scholarship (\$1,700)
- Community Service Scholarship (\$1,150)
- Diversity and Inclusion Scholarship (\$1,150)

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Graduating Senior attending a Department of Defense (DODEA) High School in Germany
- Minimum Grade Point Average (GPA): Unweighted cumulative GPA of 2.5 to 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Active participation in extracurricular activities and community service

Application Requirements

To apply, please submit the following documents:

- Complete and sign Scholarship Application Form (legal guardian information and signature required for applicants under 18)
- Official High School transcript (with unweighted GPA)
- Copy of college acceptance letter, if available
- Scholarship recipients are required to provide proof of college enrollment prior to the distribution of funds.
- Typed Scholarship Essay of 500 - 1000 words, responding to one (1) of the prompts provided.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation (see details after application form):
 - ›One (1) - Verification of community service (school, community organization, church, etc.)
 - ›Two (2) - Academic references on school letterhead



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2024 - 2025 Go to High School, Go to College Scholarship Essay Requirements

Excellence Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Academic Excellence: A history of superior academic standings and leadership involvement in extracurricular activities, clubs, and community organizations.
- Essay: Discuss the importance of education and how the applicant plans to further contribute to the development of self and others during college.

Leadership Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Leadership Experience: A history of leadership roles in school and community activities. (ex. club president, team captain, organizing school/community events.)
- Essay: Discuss the importance of leadership roles in school, community, or extracurricular activities and how their personal experiences will help them navigate college life.

Community Service Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Community Engagement: A history of volunteering and community service, demonstrating a dedication to helping others.
- Essay: Discuss what it means to be selfless and the importance of service to others through volunteering, community involvement, and how the applicant plan to contribute their service at college.

Diversity and Inclusion Scholarship

- Academic: Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Inclusive Activities: Involvement in initiatives that promote diversity and inclusion within the school or community.
- Essay: Discuss the importance of diversity of thought in community/education and how the applicant plans to contribute to a more inclusive environment during their collegiate years.

Supporting Documentation: Submission essay, recommendations, college acceptance letter(s), application signature page with parent or legal guardian signature (for applicants under 18), and the official unweighted transcript (preferred by a guidance counselor or school administrator) must be sent directly to TTL 1963 AΦA <tll1963apa@gmail.com> or via our online document upload portal link which will be provided upon verification of the online application.
